Frigyes Janza: Prologue. Training young people for policing

To define the competencies necessary to fulfil the corporate tasks successfully has been researched and developed for years with bigger or smaller stops. The final objective of this process is to answer the following question: what policemen, border guards, disaster experts we would like to recruit; what abilities, skills we have to demand and develop, and which stereotypes, prejudice, harmful or undesirable attitudes we should deal severely with.

Péter Deák: The basis of danger and conflict management concerning the system of research

The category of defence was replaced with security as a political concept after World War II and the emphasis was put on prevention and the keeping of peace. The two world wars resulted in that the defence doctrines, organizations and infrastructures became anachronism. In fact, defence is a „post factum” phenomenon, a series of actions following an armed attack in a given era, which has serious consequences for both the aggressor and the defender.

Mária Baranyai – Gábor Szakács: The possibilities to improve the training system concerning internal affairs

The training system of the internal affairs includes all the basic and further training of the effective force (regular, civil and public servants) working for the Ministry of the Interior and its institutions, which is performed in the institutions financed by the Ministry or in those of the relevant bodies. In the present study the field of policing and the trainings held especially for the effectives are mainly touched upon.

Gergely Virányi: The modernisation of the policing higher education

In the Police Academy the basic training in the full-time courses lasts for three, in the corresponding courses for four years. The Academy trains graduated experts with high qualities and the attitude of intellectuals in the frame of higher education specializations for the Police, the Border Guard, the Chief Administration of Preventing Catastrophes, the penal authorities and the Board of Customs and Excise, and the civil sphere. Those who have graduated – as members of the

effectives, or civil servants – can work first in the local, then regional and the central bodies as subordinates, then as leaders.

József Cseh: How young people are trained in policing in the Technical School for Policing in Adyliget

Today young people are trained for policing in different levels, in given training institutions, but not in an integrated training system. The training of a smaller part of teenagers begins in civil secondary schools in the frame of secondary education to prepare students for a policing career and goes on or finishes after the school leaving exams either in the technical schools for policing, other training institutions of the internal affairs or in the policing higher educational institutions.

Gábor Kovács: Young people in policing

At Zrínyi Miklós University of National Defence and in the precursor institution the training of border guard officers at a college or university level has been performed for more than 45 years. Most of the active border guard officers have graduated there. The successful training in the border policing and guarding department has basically three prerequisites: students of good quality and up-to-date training system, well-prepared teachers and modern curriculum appropriate for the claims of the border guard.

József Gubicza: The situation of the training of border guard officers at the Zrínyi Miklós University of National Defence and the timely question of reorganization

To set forth the topic of the title, to examine it comprehensively would amount to a dissertation, therefore I can undertake to give only an outline of the most important questions without the claim of completeness. In my opinion the mentioned topic can be examined in the most expedient way by placing it into a system – that of training officers and leaders on behalf of the Border Guard – and by considering the influencing and determining external factors.

László Zsolt Asztalos: The training of border guard officers in the department of border policing of the Zrínyi Miklós University of National Defence from the point of view of students

In my presentation I would like to speak about the training of border guard officers at the Zrínyi Miklós University of National Defence. The study examines the training from a rare perspective, that of the student. I would like to present the training of my year significantly, the changes affecting the other years are showed only in accordance to my knowledge.

Zsuzsanna Fodor – Márta Vízkeleti – Róbert Németh – Róbert Tanács – Balázs Viczina – János Varga: Training young people for policing from the point of view of the students of the Police Academy

The objective of the examination is to collect the experience of the first-year students of the border policing department of the Police Academy as for training young people for policing, to generalise it and to make suggestions concerning further developments.

Lajos Hargitai: About the secondary school programme of the training preparing for policing and internal affairs

Due to the significant fluctuation following the political transformation in 1992, the Police Headquarters initiated that – on the basis of an integrated training programme – training orienting young people towards policing should be started. Its aim was to improve the quality of the new generations of policemen, to evolve commitment in the new generations towards this profession, to provide sufficient information about the profession and to develop the necessary skills and abilities

Gyula Papp: The policing elective course from the standpoint of a principal

The policing elective course, started in 1996 in the vocational secondary school in Pécsvárad, was first a policing, then border policing course and since 2002 the official name of the training has become accredited training orienting to a profession of internal affairs.

In general the training can be divided into two phases: basing concerning the profession and the closely connected task of educating. The first is carried out by the experts of the police, the border guard and the body acting in catastrophes, and the latter is the task of the schools.

Zoltán Rittinger: About the experience of training for policing

We started the course preparing for policing in September 1997. The students who successfully fulfilled the admission procedure declared right after the admission which of the professions they felt commitment to, so half of the students went to the group of border guards, the other half to the group of policemen/policewomen. This decision accompanied their studies during the four years. Since 2002, after integrating the training, the basis of the theoretical preparation has been given by the accredited curriculum of the Hajnóczy József Secondary School, Human Technical School in Tiszaföldvár, hence everybody could get acquainted with the work of the police, the border guard and the defence of catastrophes, which made the training even more popular.

Ferenc Trencsényi: That starting of elective courses and the present situation

Starting the elective courses had a double aim. On one hand it aimed that young people would have a good mind to serve in the Border Guard after finishing the secondary school and that the preparation would base the border policing training; on the other hand that they would get information and knowledge which they can use in their civil life, that is in crime prevention. The instructors wanted to realize these aims when the syllabus was arranged.

Péter Zábó: Epilogue. Education and policing

The policing profession has to be made attractive and its general esteem has to be maintained with the quality assurance of the policing bodies (special allowances, attractive outlook, operation without corruption...) and with consequent enforcement of law. The place of order, discipline and policing has to be advanced to rank especially in the course of personality development, including the education in the family, kindergarden and school.
